1. **Minutes** – Helen made a <u>motion</u> to approve the November minutes as amended with one minor edit (adding "claimed"). Paul seconded the motion, and the minutes were accepted.

## 2. Old Business -

- a) **Salmon Run** The bills for the fence and the sign have been received. The sign still needs to be installed. Clean Harbors has finished the cleanup after the accident.
- **b) WRTA** There continues to be a problem behind Nucar with trash blowing down the hill to the trail. One of the dumpsters has no lid cover. Ken has taken pictures. Snow also seems to have been dumped over the embankment. The secretary will research the conditions of the site plan approval by the Planning Board. The Health Officer will look into the trash issue.

## 3. New Business:

a) Silver Lake Association request for funding- The members reviewed the letter requesting funds from the Improving and Maintaining Lakes Capital Reserve Fund. After a thorough discussion and review, the members voted unanimously to pay the requested \$3450 minus 19.37% of the state reimbursement received by the Silver Lake Association for a total of \$2277.

Helen made a **motion** to adjourn, seconded by Bob at 6:25p.m. All were in agreement.
