1. All votes taken will be by a roll call vote. The Chair then had a roll call of members present.

## 2. Old Business:

a) Arch Street Union PBN: There was a discussion of the permit application. While the two clerical errors have been corrected, the commissioners had questions about what kind of seasonal dock was being proposed. Will there be a circulator? There is no information about the design other than that it is a pipe dock that is 6 feet by forty feet. On page 6 section 12, there is no check next to the not applicable box. The commissioners are sympathetic to the applicant but feel that there is some confusion about the form and the responsibilities of the commission in regard to signing. There was also a question about the requirements of 522.06. A motion was made by Bob and seconded by Jon to not sign the PBN application and for the secretary to contact the NH Association of Conservation Commissions to request further clarification about the new NHDES forms and the responsibility of a conservation commission to waive its right to intervene. A roll call vote was held, and the motion passed unanimously.

A motion to adjourn was made by Bob and seconded by Jan. The roll call vote was unanimous, and the meeting was adjourned at 7:31 p.m.
